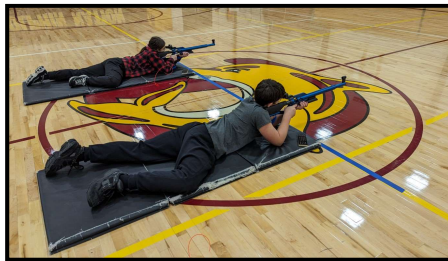


Sporter target

We will compete by shooting locally and competing nationally through postal matches.



Postal matches are where teams shoot their targets on their home ranges then send the fired targets to the match sponsor through the postal system. We will be able to compete against teams from around the country.

The CMP Postal Championship and the American Legion postal are qualifying matches.

The CMP Aces postal matches are independent quarterly matches. We will be able to fire the 4th quarter 2024, 1st and 2nd quarter 2025 matches. 3rd quarter match dates typically fall during the summer break.
